Lisa Maulding is a vice president with Coxe Curry & Associates. Her consulting experience includes internal development assessments, feasibility studies, capital campaigns and annual funds. In addition, she helped organize and implement a \$20 million capital campaign that achieved the school's first seven-figure gift, 95% parent participation and 100% faculty/staff and board participation.

From 1989 to 1995, Lisa consulted with two Atlanta fundraising consulting firms that worked throughout the southeast performing development assessments, feasibility studies and capital and annual campaigns.
